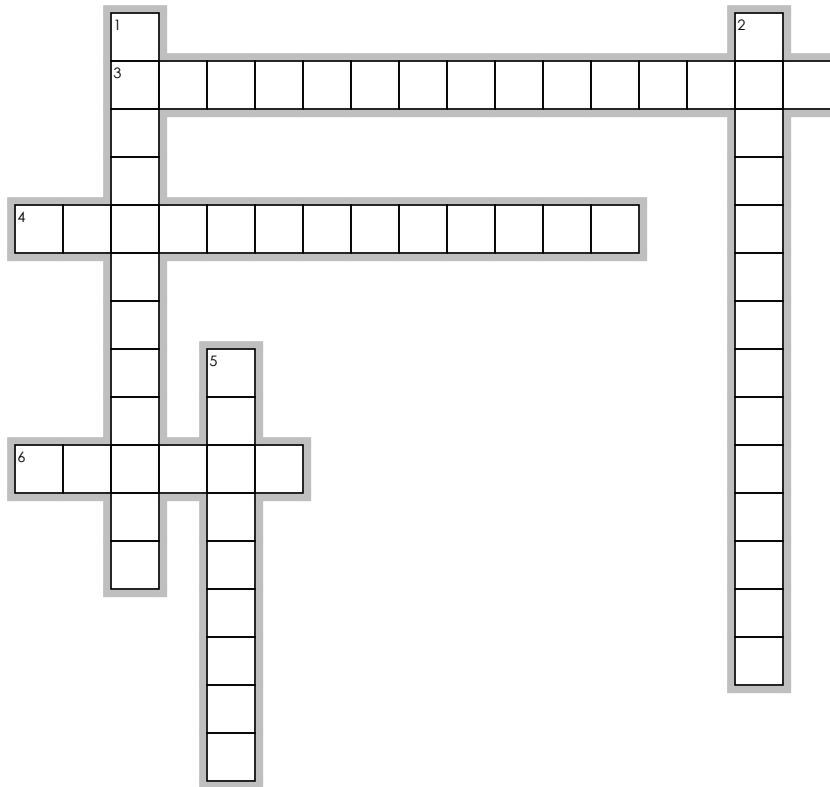

Across

3. This had a slender skull with forward pointing, spiky teeth (15)
4. This was a small, sometimes even sparrow-sized, wing fingered pterosaur. (13)
6. This appears to have had a thick, hairy coat, which would have kept the pterosaur warm during its flights. (6)

Down

1. This was one of the first birds to evolve (12)
2. This was the largest known pterosaur known, and had a wingspan of about 12m (14)
5. This had a wing-span of more than 5m, and half the length of its head consisted of a long bony crest (9)
