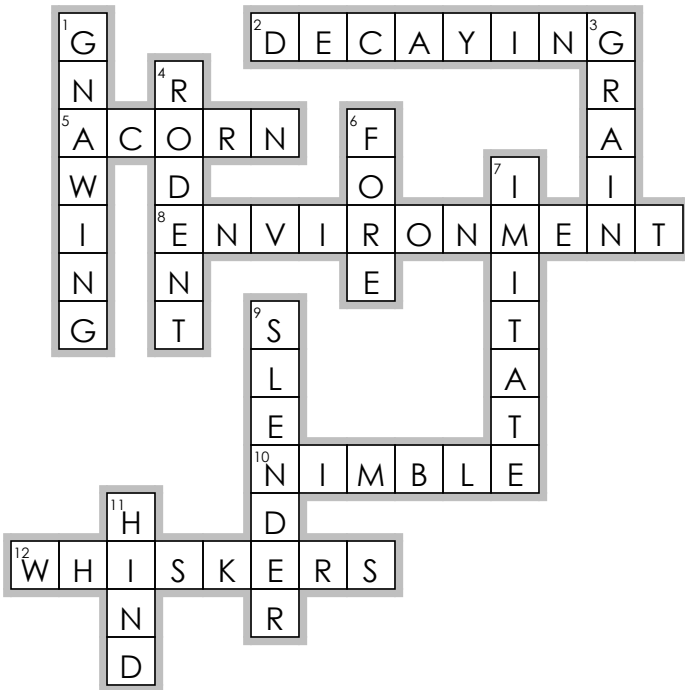

2. DECAYING — This means not fresh, going rotten. (8)
5. ACORN — This is the squirrels favourite kind of nut, and it comes from the Oak tree. (5)
8. ENVIRONMENT — This is the word we use for the place or area we live in. (11)
10. NIMBLE — This means fast and light on his feet. (6)
12. WHISKERS — These are little "feelers" that poke out of the squirrels face, on either side of his nose. (8)

1. GNAWING — The squirrel does this with his teeth. (7)
